### **MATERIALS ACCEPTED:**

- Reference works that are less than two years old
- Children's and Adult fiction that is less than **five years old** and in 'like new' condition
- Non-fiction that is less than five years old, contains current and relevant information and is in 'like new' condition
- Current DVDs and audio CDs if they are in their original cases and have copyright statements that allow for use under normal circumstances
- Magazine subscriptions

## MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED INCLUDE:

- Materials in poor condition (water or smoke damaged, torn, stained, musty/smelly, yellow pages and items damaged by animals etc.)
- Encyclopedias, textbooks or Reader's Digest Condensed Books
- Dated information (old travel guides, medical and science books)
- Old magazines or loose issues of a magazine
- VHS, Beta, cassette tapes, computer software applications
- 'Burned' or pirated copies of digital materials
- Consumables (e.g. workbooks)
- Smaller than 13 cm (standard book pocket size) Board Books excluded
- Materials that cannot be shelved (e.g. ephemera, toys)
- Materials that contravene copyright law
- Other as determined by the Director
